Lee Schornoz & Debbie Miller – "My Lover (Rmx 2016)" Press release

Lee Schornoz looks back on 30 years of musical creation in 2016. Time to look back but most of all to look forward, and to give oneself a present: a (self) remix of the song "My Lover", for which there is a colour video clip.

In the clip, Lee Schornoz plays Debbie Miller, the singer. Her background vocals were recently heard on Lee's album "Seislerbubini", which he produced together with Michel Gorski, the Sensler dialect singer and songwriter.

The vocal recordings on "My Lover" come from the first album "Louis Schornoz ,special" issued in 1997. The new song was therefore added only because Lee needed it for the video clip. He found the old version too outdated, but Debbie's vocals were necessary with Lee in the role of a woman, standing namely in the foreground. In the self-produced clip, we see Miller suffer, she looks annoyed, bored, chain-smoking. Even Lee suffered for his role: he let some portions of his body be totally depilated. The song consists of one central message, it is simple and part of a woman's daily life: "My Lover, I've just left him, he's always treated me bad!". Even death itself in the video slips into the part of the dumped lover – long live the new one!

With this package, Lee Schornoz says a definitive goodbye to his old projects after 30 years and seeks to refocus, once more, towards something musical and artistic. In the silence, he celebrates his work and (once more) stands there intentionally alone, without a band, without other musicians. The turning point is an intermediate stop within a great constant passion. Lee rose in the mid-80s as the singer of a hard rock band. Since those days, he has written texts, songs, played the guitar and the bass in several bands, sought to define his artistic horizons, in his very own sense. He kept on taking it further and a lot happened for the sheer fun of it because they enriched his life. It was his first singing teacher who left him with an important motto at the time: "Practice in itself is no art. There is art only when one goes through life with his eyes open and let it flow into the music!"

Lee Schornoz has appeared in more than 1000 private and public performances in Switzerland and abroad since 1985. He has performed with 19 different bands, released 10 albums, including 2 double albums, 13 EPs and 10 singles.
